School Activity Report October 15, 2023 to October 15, 2024

The Principal's Report 2024 provides a comprehensive overview of the school's performance and key developments over the past one year. This report serves to inform stakeholders, including members of the Board of Trustees and Managing Committee of Modern School Vasant Vihar, faculty, parents, and the wider school community, of the progress made in various domains, including academic achievements, extracurricular activities, and institutional growth.

This report highlights the accomplishments of MSVV during the year, with a particular focus on student outcomes, faculty contributions, and strategic initiatives implemented to enhance the overall learning environment. The analysis contained herein is based on data collected through academic assessments, surveys, and evaluations of the school's programs and initiatives. Additionally, the report reinforces the school's commitment to continuous development and excellence in education.

Academics

Academics form the cornerstone of a school's purpose and mission. It is through a well-structured and comprehensive curriculum that students gain the knowledge, skills, and critical thinking abilities necessary for personal and professional success. A strong academic program not only prepares students for higher education and future careers but also fosters intellectual curiosity, creativity, and a lifelong love of learning. Skills such as problem-solving, communication, and collaboration are vital for students to navigate an increasingly complex world. A robust academic foundation, a hallmark of Modern School, Vasant Vihar, supported by dedicated educators and effective teaching methods, ensures that students are equipped to meet the challenges of the future and become responsible, informed members of society.

The school adhered to the planned academic schedule, conducting all tests and examinations according to the calendar shared with parents at the beginning of the academic session.

CBSE registration for 132 and 137 students in Grades X and XII respectively, preparing for the upcoming AISSE and AISSCE, has been successfully completed in accordance with the requirements. The academic session 2023 – 24 successfully concluded with the declaration of results on March 23, 2024 for Nursery to Grade V and March 28, 2024 for Grades VI to IX & XI.

The new academic session 2024 - 25 commenced on April 1, 2024 for Kindergarten to Grade XII. In the first two weeks of April 2024, orientation sessions for parents of students from Nursery to Grade XII were organized involving the Principal, Headmistress/Supervisor, and teachers' in-charge. The sessions aimed at establishing effective communication and ensuring that parents are well-informed about key aspects of the school's operations, including academic programs, communication channels, facilities, and transportation. These orientations also provided an invaluable opportunity for parents to become acquainted with the school's environment, policies, and procedures.

Remedial classes were organized to bridge the gap for students of Grade VI to X from May 20 to 30, 2024. However, due to upwelling temperatures and government directive, they were suspended.

AISSE and AISSCE: CBSE Board Examination for Grades X and XII 2024

- Modern School, Vasant Vihar was designated as a centre for the All India Secondary School Examination (AISSE) and All India Senior School Certificate Examination (AISSCE) 2024 by the

Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE). A total of 240 students from Grade X and 275 students from XII from Guru Harkishan Public School, Vasant Vihar and Bala Pritam Guru Harkishan International Public School appeared as candidates at the Modern School, Vasant Vihar centre.

- Chinmaya Vidyalaya, Vasant Vihar was the centre of examination for 146 and 145 students of Modern School, Vasant Vihar for AISSE and the AISSCE Examinations respectively.

- Modern School, Vasant Vihar was also designated as the Spot Evaluation Centre for CBSE Grade X Science examination. Ms. Meenakshi Sahni, Former Principal, served as the Chief Nodal Supervisor (CNS) for this evaluation process and approximately 85 members including four head examiners and evaluators from other schools appointed by the CBSE were also involved. The process continued for ten days commencing on March 13, 2024.

University Visits & Student Placements for 2023-2024

Modern School, Vasant Vihar continues to stand out as a premier institution, nurturing excellence in education and holistic development. This year, we proudly hosted sessions and workshops with many prestigious universities from across the globe, enhancing our +2 students' exposure to diverse academic opportunities and career pathways.

- Modern School, Vasant Vihar hosted an orientation session by Hochschule Fulda University of Applied Sciences to support students in navigating their career paths and bridging the gap to higher education in Germany. The session, led by Julia-Sophie Rothmann, Head of the International Office, Mr. Marco Krinowski, International Marketing Manager from Hochschule Fulda University of Applied Sciences, and Mr. Timothy Strack, Language Advisor South Asia PASCH, engaged with students from Grades IX and XI on December 6, 2023. The objective was to provide valuable insights into available opportunities, offered courses, and scholarship possibilities, aiming to enlighten students about their potential higher education paths.
- On August 22, 2024, Modern School, Vasant Vihar, hosted an informative event featuring representatives from 12 renowned universities majorly from USA including DePaul University, The University of California, Davis, University at Buffalo, University of Victoria (Canada), Boston College, Penn State, DePauw University, Drexel College, Reed College, Otis College of Art & Design, University of Kansas, and Columbia College Chicago. Students and parents had the opportunity to engage directly with the university representatives, gaining valuable insights into the majors, programs, and opportunities available at these esteemed institutions. The representatives provided one-on-one guidance, addressing individual queries and offering tailored advice to help students navigate their higher education options. The event concluded on a positive note, underscoring the school's dedication to offering its students the best possible guidance and exposure to global education opportunities.
- Modern School Vasant Vihar hosted a visit from Ms. Susan Faust, Associate Dean of Undergraduate Admissions at Wake Forest University, North Carolina, on August 27, 2024. The session provided students from classes XI and XII with an excellent opportunity to explore higher education options at the university. Students engaged in meaningful discussions, learning about the various programs, the application process, campus life, accommodations, and other opportunities available. The school's counselors also connected with the representative, exchanging insights and contacts. - On September 19, 2024, career counsellor attended the University of Melbourne's inauguration event. The event featured a panel discussion with representatives from various faculties, including Engineering, Sciences, Arts, Education, and Business. The Business School highlighted exchange programs with Indian institutes such as the IIMs, offering a global perspective for students. Additionally, a new initiative, "Leading Excellence in Learning," was introduced to enhance leadership and teaching skills for educators. The event concluded with a networking session, providing valuable insights into Melbourne's academic strengths and educational leadership programs.
- The Career Fair for International Universities held on September 27, 2024 at Modern School, Vasant Vihar provided an exceptional opportunity for students of Grades IX to XII to interact directly with representatives from prestigious global universities and gain insights into various academic pathways and career opportunities.

A total of 47 universities participated in the fair, offering a diverse range of educational prospects from across the world. Among the top universities present were University College London, University of Sydney, University of Manchester, University of St. Andrews, University of Alberta, and University of Bristol and many more. Students and parents engaged in one-on-one discussions with university representatives, exploring courses, admissions processes, scholarships, and campus life, making the event both informative and interactive.

The Career Fair aimed to broaden students' perspectives on higher education options abroad and assist them in making informed decisions about their future. Feedback from students and parents was overwhelmingly positive, with many expressing appreciation for the chance to meet university representatives in person and ask questions tailored to their personal goals.

The event fostered a valuable exchange of knowledge and guidance, contributing significantly to the academic and career planning of the students.

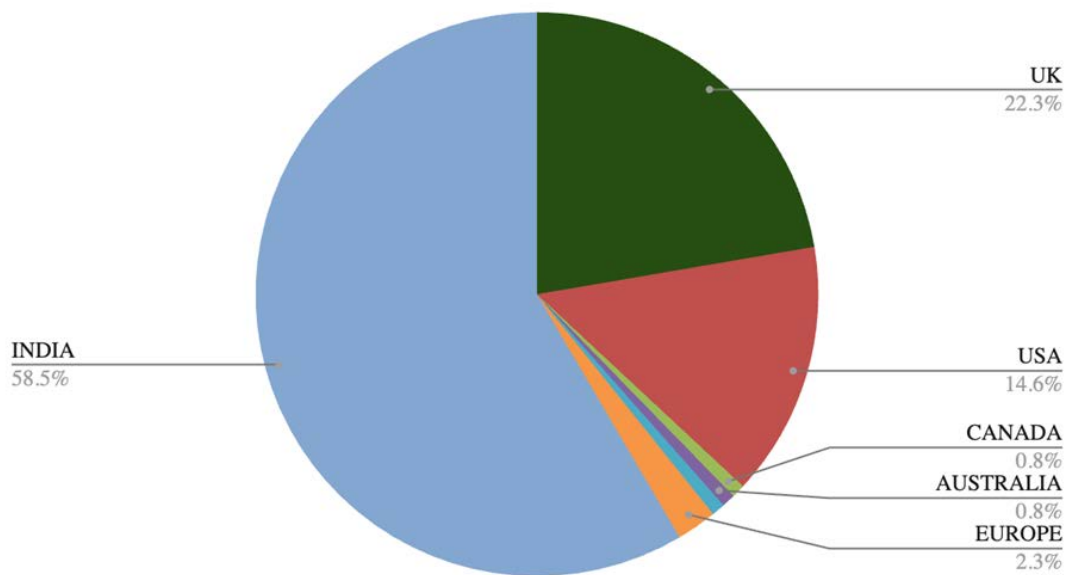
Student Placement Overview

Inclusive Education: a hallmark of our futuristic approach

Inclusive education at Modern School Vasant Vihar focuses on providing equal learning opportunities for all students, regardless of their abilities or backgrounds. The school promotes a supportive and diverse learning environment, where students with special needs are integrated into regular classrooms. Teachers and staff receive training to accommodate different learning styles, ensuring that each student can participate fully and achieve their potential.

The salient activities that marked the calendar of 2023-24:-

- The annual 5 day Dyslexia awareness camp was organised in October 2023. This featured remedial sessions, incorporating occupational therapy
- A workshop on Learning Support: Perspectives, Possibilities and Perspectives, by Ms. Anita Brady.
- Students were encouraged to scribe for children with learning disabilities from Amity University. Students who pioneered this were; Sabrina Malhotra, Aarav Bidichandani, Kavi Arora and Vanya Nanda.
- World Autism day was celebrated through art at Tamanna School
- Orkids Foundation organised a 2 day peer sensitization workshop for Middle school
- The Primary School Teachers were the beneficiaries of a session on screening children for special needs, by Geet Oberoi, Founder of Orkids
- Under the Dyslexia awareness month, students were taken to Lemon Tree hotel, to experience and assess inclusivity in the hospitality industry.

MIE Project: Time Travel – Traversing the past through the lens of the present

The school embarked on the project "Time Travel: Traversing the Past Through the Lens of the Present," conceived by Ms. Ambika Pant, Honorary Secretary of the Board of Trustees at Modern School. Aligned with Modern's ethos of integrating culture and heritage with education, the project aims to inspire students to conduct comprehensive studies of local heritage sites, fostering appreciation for cultural diversity, historical significance, and a sense of identity and belonging. The goal is to culminate the project with an exhibition on Founder's Day in October 2024. Ms. Aseema Gokhale, with extensive experience working with INTACH, has been appointed to lead the project, overseeing its structure, refinement, and implementation. She participated in an orientation program by Modern Institute for Education at Lodhi Gardens on December 12, 2024.

The orientation program included educators from all branches of Modern School where they undertook insightful exploration led by Ms. Beeba Sobti. The purpose of this visit was to immerse the educators in a historical time travel experience, fostering a deeper understanding of the past through a contemporary lens.

Under the guidance of Ms. Beeba Sobti, the group embarked on a journey that can aptly be described as 'immersive learning.' The exploration began at Gate 1 (Ashoka Gate) of Lodhi Garden and concluded at Khan Market. Throughout the walk, Ms. Beeba Sobti shared a plethora of anecdotes and musings, enriched with historical opulence gleaned from Lodhi Garden.

The participants were captivated by the monumental details, craftsmanship, and grandeur presented by both Lodhi Garden and Khan Market. The excursion extended beyond these locations, encompassing Ambassador Hotel and Sujan Singh Park, ultimately concluding at RSJMS.

This visit proved to be an excellent example of educational enrichment, seamlessly blending historical insights with contemporary perspectives. The experience transported participants back in time, providing a unique lens through which to view and appreciate the rich heritage embedded in these historical landmarks.

The meeting and subsequent exploratory walk not only deepened the educator’s understanding of historical contexts but also underscored the potential of experiential learning in the academic sphere. The immersive approach employed during this session aligns with the Modern School's commitment to fostering a holistic and enriched educational experience.

The insights gained from this meeting will undoubtedly contribute to the ongoing discourse on innovative pedagogical approaches, emphasizing the significance of incorporating real-world experiences into the educational framework.

The MIE project: Time Travel – Traversing the past through the lens of the present was introduced to students of Grades IV to XII where each grade was allotted a unique Heritage Site of Delhi within a 15 km radius from Modern School Vasant Vihar:

Junior Astitva Samman February 2024

Students of Modern School, Vasant Vihar were the proud recipients of Junior Astitva Samman for the eighth consecutive year since the inception of the honour. The school had submitted five nominations out of which the jury comprising seven members selected three projects for recognition which included:

AI vs Real World Hunger- Anandini Suri, Class XI

Aim: To spread awareness about food wastage to inspire individuals to adopt more sustainable practices in their daily lives.

Game Changer - Sustainability in Motion- Jay Verma, Class XI

Aim: To spread awareness on the prevalence of financial spams and frauds and educating people especially senior citizens on ways to protect their life savings with the knowledge gained. The project involved various resources such as National Cyber Crime Reporting portal, police station amongst others.

Scams & Frauds - Menace to Society- Kavi Arora, Class XI

Aim: To promote sustainability by recycling waste generated by sports such as balls etc. to reduce environment impact. Jay set a new example such as speaker from discarded cricket balls and proposed to sell them in order to raise funds for generating scholarships or coaching facilities for underprivileged sportspersons.

Pramerica Spirit of Community Awards

The Pramerica Spirit of Community Awards is an annual nationwide search to identify and recognize school students who have made a positive difference in their communities through volunteer community service. Students can participate in the program individually or as a team. This year, Jay Verma had been shortlisted as one of the top 25 finalists for the Pramerica Life Insurance Emerging Visionaries. He was awarded the silver medallion for his extraordinary vision, initiative and dedication towards community service.

World Scholar's Cup

Five students from MSVV showcased their intellectual prowess at the World Scholar's Cup Tournament of Champions held at Yale University from November 2 to 7, 2023. Engaging in debates, writing, and academic challenges, they competed among 2800 students from 80 countries, demonstrating excellence in various categories.

This session too, more than 55 students across the junior and senior section participated in the World Scholar Cup held from April 13 to 16, 2024 in Gurugram this year. One of the highest ranking teams at the competition comprised Ojas Panda, Ekam Suri and Eshanya Nahar of Grade IX. They ranked as the 5th top team in the Scholars Bowl and 2nd champion team overall, receiving trophies for both. Sean Karam received 12 medals including 7 gold. Karun Kumar Warriar, student of grade VIII received 8 medals including 4 golds. Most of the students who attended qualified for the 2024 Global Round of the World Scholar's Cup.

Notable participation and laurels of students

- A certificate of commendation was awarded to Aditi Azad, Grade XI for her painting on the theme 'Travel Diaries' in ICS International Painting Competition organized by the Institute for Career Studies (ICS) in November 2023. Aditi's painting was selected for the ICS Calendar 2024.
- The Youth Course Scholarships for the PASCH SCHOOL Young German learners is organised every year by Goethe Institut. This year also being a PASCH School two students Sara Gupta and Aarav Singhal of class IX gave an online interview on 21 February 2024. Sara Gupta, Grade XI attended the prestigious Jugendkurs 2024 – Youth scholarship camp in Germany from June 30 to July 20, 2024. This camp is organized annually by the Goethe Institute, Max Mueller Bhawan for PASCH school and Sara was selected after rigorous rounds of interview.
- CBSE in collaboration with IBM has launched 'Sustainability Accelerator' for students with the aim of accelerating a sustainability mindset in youth and advancing skills for green jobs. Armaan Ahluwalia, Rudraxi Singh, Vanya Nanda, and Zaina Lohia of Grade XI participated in the program. The program is designed to provide hands-on experience to high school students. **Vanya Nanda** qualified for the fourth (final) round based on her business idea. Vanya Nanda has authored a book titled 'Lakeerein - Disability or Impairment?' touching upon the social model of disability with an aim to break down walls of discrimination.
- Shri Ram College of Commerce, University of Delhi organized the National Economics Olympiad with 6500 students from prestigious schools including The British School, DPS, Dhirubhai Ambani International School, Delhi Private School Dubai participating in the first round. 20 students from Grade XII Economics group of MSVV were a part of this event.

Aagatsya Jaipuria, Sarthak Mundhra, and Anaya Sharma, advanced to the final round. Aagatsya Jaipuria secured the 3rd rank and Sarthak Mundhra secured the 25th rank.

- The record for being the ‘Youngest Indian to lap a FIA Accredited Formula 1 racetrack’ has been set by Shrey Titus of K.G. He completed 4 laps by driving 5.125 km at the Buddh International Circuit. Shrey’s achievement was recognized through a citation and gained an entry in the India Book of Records.
- Shivin Jain, Grade VI, was awarded the ABRSM Level 2 Certificate in Graded Examination in Music Performance (Grade 4)

In House Activities

Special Assemblies and House assemblies

Workshops/Interactive Sessions/Visits for students

The tour consisted of a visit to the Museum within the NASC complex. The visit to Museum and fruit exhibition as well as the interaction by DG, ICAR and Assistant DG, ICAR was informative and relevant to Biology students of Grade XI and XII.
- The exhibition on ‘Heritage Sites in India, recognized by UNESCO’ was organized by RS Junior Modern School on July 20, 2024 which consisted of display boards/models on various heritage sites made by students of Grade I to V. With Central Board of Secondary Education

- Awareness Campaign against Drug Abuse...Say No To Drugs And Yes To Life
Modern School, Vasant Vihar hosted an awareness campaign against drug abuse...SAY NO TO DRUGS and YES TO LIFE organized by the Central Board of Secondary Education in collaboration with Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) on August 28, 2024.
The program commenced with a welcome address by the Principal, Ms. Vibha Khosla. The keynote speakers for the campaign were Mr. Himanshu Gupta, Secretary, CBSE, Mr. Neeraj Kumar Gupta, Deputy Director, NCB, and Mr. N. Mrinal, Additional Director, NCB.
The speakers highlighted the critical issue of substance abuse and explained causes, effects and prevention strategies. Also, how we as educators and family could create a supportive environment for our youth. An interactive question and answer session clarified various queries that students had.
The campaign was live streamed pan India on the CBSE YouTube channel and saw the participation of more than 7000 students, parents, educators online. Grades VIII to XII students and teaching fraternity of Modern School, Vasant Vihar attended the informative session offline.

- To raise awareness and understanding among students about the diverse needs, challenges, and experiences of their peers, especially those who may be differently-abled, have special needs, or come from diverse backgrounds, Peer Sensitization workshop was conducted for Middle School Students by ORKIDS Foundation on August 28 and 29, 2024. The following members of the ORKIDS Foundation conducted the session: Ms. Charu Khanna (Senior head of teaching training Programme); Ms. Neha Gard (resource center coordinator); Ms. Ritu Maheshwari (Special Educator) and Ms. Gurpreet Kaur Walia (Resource Center Coordinator)

The goal was to foster empathy, inclusivity, and a supportive school environment.

Group discussions, activities that simulate challenges faced by peers; visual aids depicting real-life scenarios, etc. were conducted so that students could feel more connected to their peers, and be better equipped to contribute to a positive, inclusive school culture.

- On September 12, 2024, the teachers of Grades III to V participated in an informative and practical workshop on Early Screening for Developmental Disabilities. The session was conducted by Ms. Geet Oberoi, Founder of ORKIDS. By focusing on conditions like Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), Attention Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD), learning disabilities and speech/language delays, Ms. Oberoi emphasized the importance of early detection, noting that timely intervention could significantly improve outcomes for children with developmental challenges. This collaborative approach ensures that children who may be at risk of developmental delays receive comprehensive and well-rounded support from a multidisciplinary team.

A key highlight of the workshop was the hands-on training session where teachers were introduced to the Orkids Screening Tool App. This app serves as a practical resource for identifying early indicators of developmental delays. The teachers engaged in mock screening sessions, enabling them to practice using the app and gain confidence in applying it to real-life scenarios.

By enhancing their skills in early identification and intervention, the teachers are now better prepared to support students with developmental disabilities, ensuring a brighter and more inclusive future for every child in their care.

With MSVV Alumni Association

- Modernites Fur U: Animal Welfare Workshop

Aimed to increase students' awareness of animal behaviour and emotional as well as physical health and issues of animal welfare, thereby dispelling fears and prejudices and fostering empathy. The awareness sessions are divided into various modules which are theme and issue based. The first session was conducted by Ms Devyani Rao (1998) for students of Class VI and served as an introduction to the programme wherein the need for peaceful coexistence between animals and humans and the need for empathy towards animals was highlighted.

After completion of modules, it is proposed to start an Animal Lover's Club with voluntary membership, to take forward what has been learnt here. Activities of the Club may include fund-raising for shelters, articles in the school magazine, bulletin board highlighting important animal-related issues, stall at the fete, movie screenings, etc. Alumni are happy to act as mentors and remain engaged.

- Eye Check up Camp

In collaboration with Shroff Eye Center, a luminary in the field of ophthalmology, conducted eye check ups for the students and staff of MSVV. Using the latest machines and equipment, the examinations conducted were useful for further follow up and also quite satisfying with reference to eye health. Qualified doctors engaged with the examinees to offer sound, professional advice.

With MIE (Modern Institute for Education)

- Modern School, Vasant Vihar hosted Transformative Leadership: Enhancing Social, Emotional and Ethical Learning (SEEL)– a two day capacity building program conducted by the Modern Institute for Education for the staff members holding leadership positions under the Principal of Modern Schools.

Ms. Geeta Rawat, Headmistress – Junior School; Ms. Alka Choudhary, Supervisor – Senior School; Ms. Rachna, Supervisor – Secondary School; Ms. Poonam Gogia, Supervisor – Middle School and Ms. Anu Mathur, Coordinator from Modern School, Vasant Vihar attended the workshop.

The core aim of the workshop was to make school leaders understand the framework of SEEL and equip them with tools and techniques to implement it in their schools.

Day 1:

Facilitators: Mr. Aditya Gupta, Member of Board of Trustees, Modern School Society; Ms. Pratima Mittal, Director IPC Gulf; Ms. Vibha Khosla Principal

Ms. Pratima Mittal discussed the process through which all young people and adults acquire and apply the knowledge, skills, and attitudes to develop healthy identities, manage emotions and achieve personal and collective goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain supportive relationships, and make responsible, ethical and caring decisions.

Mr. Aditya Gupta emphasized the fundamental and innate nature of integrity and leadership. According to him, integrity is a fundamental quality that a leader either possesses or does not; it is not something that can be partially acquired or used selectively. He believed that integrity and leadership go hand in hand, with true leaders embodying honesty, transparency, and a strong moral compass. Leadership loses its meaning and becomes hollow and ineffectual when it lacks integrity.

Ms. Vibha Khosla talked about ethical decision-making and leadership qualities with emphasis on self-love and compassion. She said that without loving oneself one can never spread love, and happiness, and could not also acquire social skills. It's essential to practice empathy towards self in order to inculcate this skill among students and people around.

Day 2:

The focus was on academic success and how a high IQ frequently causes people to ignore important competencies like creativity, emotional intelligence, and resilience. This can hinder an individual's potential to grow holistically by impeding their capacity for innovation, adaptation, and meaningful interpersonal connections. Beyond merely acquiring knowledge, true intelligence includes the capacity to manage difficult situations in life, comprehend the feelings of others, and apply knowledge in a variety of real-world contexts. To make teachers grasp the concept better, a decision-making activity was conducted. It transpired that the issue is not about taking right or wrong decisions but it is more about taking decisions based on the immediate circumstances.

Ms. Vibha Khosla emphasized the superiority of the Emotional Quotient (EQ) over the Intelligence Quotient (IQ). She cited examples of student substance usage and resolving conflicts among co-workers to elucidate what ethical leadership looks like when practiced. Also, the importance of preserving privacy, obtaining proof, and consulting school counsellors was emphasized.

The workshop concluded with interactive sessions and conversations about preserving self-compassion, controlling emotional outbursts, and the significance of uncompromising leadership values. Through a number of examples, videos, and activities the participants were made to realise that simply changing behaviour of everyday practices can bring revolutionary changes in their personalities as well as the behaviour of the students.

With other agencies

On May 14, 2024, a comprehensive Drill for Disaster Management was conducted to train students in effective and rapid evacuation procedures. The drill was designed to enhance students' preparedness and response skills in the event of an emergency, ensuring their safety and well-being. During the exercise, students were guided through the steps of a swift and orderly evacuation from the school building. The drill simulated various emergency scenarios, allowing students to practice their roles and familiarize themselves with evacuation routes and safety protocols.

The event was a part of our ongoing commitment to ensuring that all students are equipped with the knowledge and skills needed to handle emergency situations with confidence and efficiency. The drill was a crucial step in fostering a culture of preparedness and resilience within the school community.

On July 15, 2024, Modern School, Vasant Vihar, was selected as the center for a Disaster Management Familiarization Exercise (FAMEX). This initiative aimed to raise awareness about mitigating the impacts of disasters such as earthquakes and floods, which are significant risks in Delhi.

A twenty-two member team from the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) conducted the exercise, providing first hand training to students from Grades VI to XII and all staff members teaching these classes. The training included a demonstration of the CPR technique on a mannequin. The event was an invaluable learning experience, equipping participants with various rescue operation techniques and enhancing their preparedness for potential disasters.

Visit by Holton Arms School

Modern School, Vasant Vihar, in partnership with Holton Arms School in Washington, DC, conducted a successful two-day foreign exchange program on July 24 and 25, 2024, aimed at fostering cross-cultural understanding, academic collaboration, and building lasting international friendships.

The event featured a diverse range of activities, including the making of chia pudding, traditional art forms like Saanji and Warli, clay modeling, and an interactive talk designed to engage and enrich the participants. These activities encompassed various interests and skills, providing a well-rounded experience.

The interactive talk between students of Modern School, Vasant Vihar, and Holton Arms School facilitated an exchange of ideas and experiences between young girls from two diverse educational systems. The aim of this discussion was to explore and understand each other's curriculum, share future aspirations, and discuss diverse areas of interest for higher studies. Eight senior students who hosted the guests were Anandini Suri, Divisha Kohli, Geetanshu Gulati, Jiya Behl, Nayan Kapoor, and Saanvi Gupta.

Trips and Excursions

Modern School organizes a variety of educational trips that provide students with hands-on, experiential learning opportunities beyond the classroom. These experiences inspire curiosity, a love for learning, and a deeper connection to the world around them.

Club Activities

Clubs provide students with platforms to develop essential life skills, such as leadership, teamwork, problem-solving, and time management. Whether it's a debate club, robotics club, or drama society, each club hones unique abilities relevant to students' personal and professional growth. These allow students to pursue their passions and interests outside the standard curriculum. Whether in music, arts, sports, or academic-focused clubs, students can discover and nurture their talents in a supportive environment. Clubs complement academic learning by promoting creativity, critical thinking, and innovation. For example, a science club may involve hands-on experiments, while a literature club might encourage creative writing and discussion, enriching students' learning experiences.

Environment Club

The Environment Club of MSVV is a student-led group dedicated to promoting environmental awareness and sustainability. Members engage in activities such as recycling drives, tree planting, energy conservation campaigns, and eco-friendly projects. The club also educates the school community on the importance of protecting the environment and encourages sustainable practices in daily life. A series of activities undertaken during this academic session are as follows:

Grade XI students organized an assembly on 'Save Wetlands,' about the significance of wetlands in the ecosystem, including their role in nutrient recycling, organism life cycles, and groundwater table replenishment.

- A special assembly was conducted with the focus on raising awareness about alarming air pollution levels, the accelerating pace of climate change, and the diverse hazards associated with industrialization, urbanization, and insufficient waste management. A collective pledge to avoid using firecrackers and single-use plastic, demonstrating their commitment to an environmentally conscious celebration of Diwali, was taken.
- The Green Brigade Club at Modern School, Vasant Vihar, organized a successful e-waste and book donation drive for Grades VI-XII in the month of April 2024.
- The Earth Day Assembly focused on "Planet vs Plastic," raising awareness about plastic pollution. Students pledged to safeguard the environment, and the assembly concluded with practical suggestions for reducing plastic waste.
- In a Tree Plantation Drive: "Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam", students from Grades VI-XII planted saplings at home or in their localities and pledged to care for them.

- Six students of Grade VII performed a skit on 'Swabhav Swachhata - Sanskaar Swachhata,' raising awareness about cleanliness, organized by the Ministry of Jal Shakti and Housing & Urban Affairs.
- Students created impactful slogans, posters, and pamphlets on water conservation and environmental issues. Middle school students actively participated, spreading awareness on environmental responsibility.

Heritage Club

The Heritage Club focuses on preserving and promoting Delhi's rich cultural and historical heritage. Students participate in activities like heritage walks, visits to historical sites, workshops on traditional arts and crafts, and festivals celebrating local culture. The club aims to raise awareness about India's diverse heritage and encourages students to take pride in and contribute to its preservation.

- Three students from Modern School, Vasant Vihar – Samarvir Sabharwal (7B), Anaisha Chug (7A), and Reyanshi Jain (6D) – attended the content aspect of the FILMIT Workshop held on July 23, 2024. Ms. Purnima Dutt introduced the importance of spreading cultural and heritage awareness, while Mr. Faisal Alkazi provided valuable insights into film-making themes, techniques, and storytelling elements like suspense and music. Students also watched past films made in the FILMIT program and participated in an engaging discussion. On the second day on July 25, 2024, Aahaana Mulchandani (7A), Aryaman Aggrawal (8C), and Nehmat (6C) attended the technical aspect of the workshop. Mr. Anshul and Ms. Himanshi Jain introduced various filming techniques, including different camera angles and shots like panoramic views and over-the-shoulder shots. The students then applied their learning by shooting a 1-1.5 minute video, making it a practical and enriching experience.
- On October 3, 2024, four students - Shreya Arora and Vanshika Baid from Grade IX and Tvisha Mittal and Saanvi Gupta from Grade X took part in the National Heritage Quiz 2024 based on Indian Heritage and Culture organized by Indian National Trust for Art and Cultural Heritage (INTACH). The quiz covered a wide range of topics, including Indian history, architecture, art, music, traditions and famous heritage sites.

Debating Society

The Debating Club of a school is a student-led organization where students develop their public speaking, critical thinking, and argumentation skills. Members participate in structured debates on various topics, fostering healthy discussion and improving their ability to present and defend viewpoints. The club often competes in inter-school debate competitions, encouraging teamwork and intellectual growth.

- The annual event Mod-Debate was organised after extensive preparation. Senior members of the club actively spectated the debates of junior students, providing constructive feedback and identifying potential participants. In addition, they assisted in the editing and refining of speeches to ensure they were clear, coherent, and persuasive. The preparation involved organizing multiple practice sessions, coordinating schedules, and making general arrangements to ensure the event ran smoothly.
- Expanding our society was another key focus. We recruited new members through a form provided by the school, allowing us to gauge their interests.
- One of our students, trained by senior board members, participated in an external debate competition of WSC Global Round. This achievement, although briefly mentioned here, is a testament to the rigorous training and mentorship provided by our club.

The Electoral Literacy Club

The Electoral Literacy Club of a school aims to educate students about the electoral process and the importance of voting. Through activities like mock elections, debates, and workshops, the club

fosters an understanding of democratic values and civic responsibilities. It encourages students to become informed, responsible citizens who actively participate in the democratic process.

- Assembly regarding importance of elections in light of the 2024 Lok Sabha Elections and relevance for students conducted on April 18 th (for Senior School) April 19 th (for Middle School). A Pledge (given by the Election Commission of India) was also undertaken by the students.
- An Instagram page was created in May. This was used extensively to spread awareness through posts and reels about relevant topics such as importance of voting and voting rights, Inclusive Measures of Polling etc.

Lifestyle Club

The Lifestyle Club of a school focuses on promoting healthy and balanced living among students. It encourages wellness through activities such as fitness sessions, nutrition workshops, mindfulness practices, and discussions on maintaining mental and emotional health. The club aims to inspire students to adopt positive habits for a well-rounded, healthy lifestyle. Members were an integral part of all the school functions, that included Managing Committee meetings, inauguration of the turf etc. In the month of September, as part of the Rashtriya Poshan Maah celebration, middle school students brought nutritious tiffins and gave talks on the importance of nutrients for maintaining good health.

Cognitive Crew (Psychology Club)

- The Psychology Club of a school is a student-led group focused on exploring topics related to human behavior, mental health, and the mind. Members engage in discussions, workshops, and activities that promote understanding of psychological concepts, raise awareness about mental health, and provide a supportive space for students to learn about and discuss mental well-being.
- August 2024, centered around a field visit and ongoing activities aimed at enhancing students' understanding of psychological concepts.

The **Cyber Squad** Team created an AV presentation on Cyber Security, which was shown to students from Grades 5 to 8 by their respective Computer teachers, to raise awareness about various aspects of online safety; such as identifying phishing scams, safeguarding personal information, creating strong passwords, and recognizing the dangers of cyberbullying, to help students protect themselves against online theft and threats.

Interact Club

The Community Service Club of a school focuses on helping others through volunteer work and charitable activities. Members participate in projects like organizing food drives, visiting senior homes, tutoring younger students, and raising funds for local causes. The club aims to instill a sense of responsibility, compassion, and civic duty in students while making a positive impact on the community.

- **NGO Sports Meet:** An annual event was organized by the Club on December 21, 2023. The Chief Guest on the occasion was Ms. Ambika Pant, Hon. Secretary, Board of Trustees, Modern Schools and Ms. Sumaya Dalmia, Founder & CEO, SD Wellness Private Limited was the Guest of Honour.
Ten NGOs participated in the Sports Meet: Ishwar, Shakti foundation, Spread a smile, Taleem, Udayan, Vidya, Prajna, Salaam Balak Trust, Little India Foundation and Maitri.
- **Bake Sale** (held on August 9, 2024) - This event is expected to be a significant fundraising opportunity, with new members playing a vital role in supporting the club's social service initiatives. The Interact Club continues to promote a spirit of service and leadership among

its members, marking a great start to the new academic year. The bake sale was a huge success and the collection was approximately 1 lakh.

- Appointment of Addl district Interact Representative: Vanya Nanda, President of the Interact Club at Modern School Vasant Vihar, has been selected as the Additional District Interact Representative (ADIR), a prestigious recognition that reflects his commitment and leadership within the Interact Club. Astronomy Club

As the first activity of the session on August 22, 2024, club members were briefed on ISRO's Chandrayaan-3 mission. They were introduced to the mission's main objectives and the launch vehicle, LVM-3-M4, learning about its staging process and propulsion model. The session included a detailed analysis of the Lunar Transfer Orbit and the mission's payloads, where students explored the thermophysical measurements, the ILSA instrument, and the Langmuir Probe. This engaging discussion provided members with a deeper understanding of India's advancements in lunar exploration.

On September 27, 2024, a post-school session on Hydro Rockets was organized for club members in collaboration with SPACE India. During the session, SPACE educators introduced students to the fundamental structure of a rocket, explaining key components such as the nose cone, payload, storage, and nozzle. They also provided a scientific overview of rocket launches to ignite students' enthusiasm for physics.

The highlight of the session was a hands-on demonstration where students learned how to construct a rocket and followed the procedures for its launch. Under the guidance of SPACE India specialists, students excitedly attempted to launch their rockets to the highest possible altitudes.
